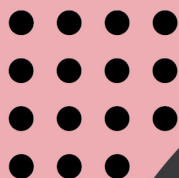

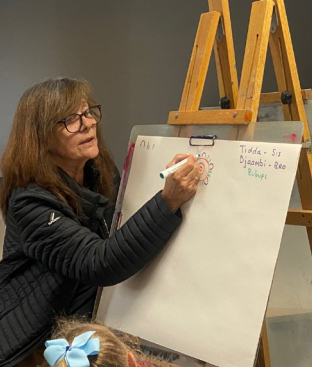


Aboriginal Infusion

Chinese Ribbon Dance

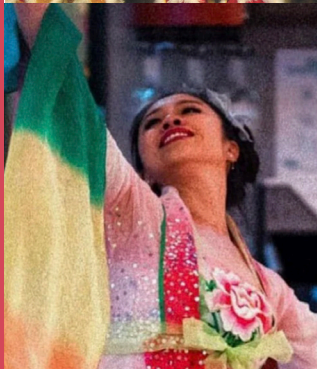
