The climactic scenes are based on Hindu epics, such as the Ramayana Cycle. A truly magical experience!

Sound of Multicultural Australia Trio

The Sound of Multicultural Australia Trio is a combination of ancient melodies and African rhythms woven into compositions that can only be found in Australia. The Trio comprises a world-renowned musician, Uygu, Ghanian elder, Yaw and percussionist, Richard who invites the musicians to share their culture.







Bali in Motion

Bali in Motion provides students with the opportunity to experience a true taste of Balinese cultural activities! Music, dance and the visual arts form a foundation for traditional Balinese life, and myths and legends are incorporated into these arts.

Indonesian Infusion

Indonesian Infusion will take participants on an immersive and interactive journey, showcasing the amazing diversity of the Indonesian community. Through customs, language, dance, traditional dress and music, the presenters explore the islands of Sumatra, Java, Bali and more.

Bollywood Infusion

Bollywood is an important part of modern Indian culture, referring to the Hindi film industry, and categorised by colourful displays of music, dance, and costume. Bollywood Infusion presents a vibrant workshop where participants will learn about the folk and classical origins of the Bollywood dances.

Classical Indian Dance

Immerse your students in the culture of ancient India that is still practised to this day in the workshop. After a fantastic performance set to the sound of classical instruments and Sanskrit chants, students will learn some of the symbolic gestures and movements and the stories they tell.

Chinese Calligraphy & Brush Ink Painting

Using brush strokes and painted characters this interactive workshop focuses on imagery and selfexpression. Originating from the year 618, students will learn and explore the significance of Chinese Calligraphy & Brush Ink Painting in Chinese culture.

Chinese Classical Dance

Chinese Classical Dance presents incredible performances of classical folk dances from across China, including the Lantern Dance, Ribbon Dance and Fan Dance. Participants will learn a short routine using some of the steps alongside traditional and contemporary Chinese music.

Chinese Drumming

The earliest known drums in China date back to four thousand years ago! A performance of rhythm and colour, students will love this handson Chinese Drumming workshop as they drum out beats and learn about instruments behind the popular Lion Dance and Kung Fu soundtracks.

Chinese Fan Dance

A symbol of beauty and grace, Chinese Fan Dance is a colourful captivating workshop that will get students moving with their own fans as they learn all about the Chinese Fan Dance and its origins.







Chinese Fan Painting

Fans are an integral part of Chinese lifestyle and are important artefacts in Chinese history and culture. In this workshop, participants will have the opportunity to decorate paper panels of the folding fan, providing a blank canvas to express their creativity.

Chinese Lion Dance

Signifying good fortune, prosperity and longevity, the Chinese Lion Dance is an art form dating back to the 12th century! This workshop will give students an opportunity to see the Lion up close.

Chinese Martial Arts

Martial arts, also traditionally known as wüshù in Mandarin, are art forms dating back more than 4000 years ago. In Chinese Martial Arts, a high energy educational workshop, participants get to delve into the history and philosophy of martial arts in China as well as trying out different styles such as Tai-Chi for themselves.

Chinese Lantern Decorating



As a special tradition in the Moon Cake Festival, participants will be invited to decorate Chinese Lanterns with traditional patterns. Lanterns are an important symbol of wealth and good fortune in the Mooncake festival.

Vietnamese Classical Dance

Predominantly performed during Lunar New Year and Mid-Autumn Festival, Vietnamese Classical Dance has been an innate part of Vietnamese culture since ancient times; dating as far back as 600BCE! Traditional dance in Vietnam represent the harmony of Vietnamese cultures and the people.

Korean Classical Dance

Korean Classical Dance engages your students in the sights and sounds of enduring art forms from Korea! Tracing back 5000 years ago to its Shamanistic origins, this engaging program offers a captivating introduction to traditional Korean and folk dances, exploring the culture and history behind these mesmerising forms of expression.

Korean K-pop Dance



In this exciting workshop, students will explore all things K – pop! This workshop will start with a skilled performance by our presenters, followed by a lesson on popular K –pop dance moves including the 'BangBang Bang' and 'Mic Drop'.









Brazilian Drumming

Brazilian Drumming is a loud and fabulous introduction to Brazilian culture! The presenters will introduce the history, rhythms and culture of Brazil including Carnival and the famous Olodum drumming group. Presenters will provide metal buckets for the students so they can learn how to drum. They will be taught various Brazilian rhythms in this Brazilian Drumming workshop.

Cool Capoeira

An art form that emerged from enslaved Africans in Brazil, disguising their fight into a dance, Capoeira has evolved to become one of the most fascinating combination of dance and martial arts movements in the world. An endangered art form, Cool Capoeira introduces the history and evolution to its special protected status as intangible cultural heritage by UNESCO.

Latin American Dance

Explore the vibrant world of Latin American dance through an engaging demonstration of styles such as salsa, cha-cha-cha, merengue, bachata, and tango. Discover the rich cultural significance of these dances as participants gain a deeper connection to the rhythms and traditions of Latin America.

Viva Mexico - A Cultural Journey

In Viva Mexico – A Cultural Journey, Victor performs with instruments including the Mexican harp, Mexican and Spanish guitars, violin and trumpet. Students will learn folk dances and the meaning of Spanish lyrics found in La Bamba and other popular songs. Victor will explain the cultural history of the instruments and the Charro suit worn by the Mariachis.

Tirol Dancing

Join Rowan for an incredible performance of high-energy, intricate Bavarian folk dances in Tirol Dancing! He will demonstrate various German and Austrian traditional dances such as the Waltz, Polka and Zwiefacher. Students will also have the chance to learn how to do the energetic Schuhplattler- the famous German slap dance.

Mime Magnifique!

Our Mime Magnifique! program is filled with action, fun and festivities. Taking participants on a journey exploring French culture and history, they will learn the significance of the French artform of mime. With charades, magic tricks, and more, the presenter brings theatre to life in a highly interactive and engaging workshop.

Classic French Music

In Classic French Music, Peter and Marie are joined by French cabaret singer Corrine, to present classics of early 20th century Paris. The trio play and contextualises the music by introducing the lyrics, instruments and cultural context in French and English according to the student's level.

Yoga and Mindfulness

Yoga and Mindfulness engages participants in this ancient practice that uses breathing, flexibility, and strength to boost mental and physical wellbeing. The presenter will share the symbolism and cultural history of yoga, flowing yoga postures, classical hand gestures, meditation, and breath techniques that are tailored to all ages and abilities.







Egyptian Rhythms and Dance

Egyptian Rhythms and Dance explores Egyptian culture through dance, music and engaging discussion. Students will learn about the cultural significance of regional dances, and the evolution of social folk dance to stage performance.
