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The Wayang Golek Wooden Puppetry


Give students a wonderful insight into the myths and legends of Indonesian history and culture. The stories are presented through wooden puppet dolls in colourful costumes who serve as symbols of Indonesian art. Features the Hindu folklore 'The Legend of Ramayana and Mahabharata".

The Wayang Kulit Shadow Puppetry

A theatrical shadow play based on the Hindu folklore 'The Legend of Ramayana and Mahabharata". Students are given an opportunity to watch the shadow puppetry from both sides of the screen to experience the magic behind this ancient art form.




Sumardi will guide students to make their own shadow puppets. The students will learn about the usage of specific characters and colours, as well as their symbolic meanings.











Chinese Martial Arts

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Martial arts, also traditionally known as wushu in Mandarin, are art forms dating back more than 4000 years ago. In Chinese Martial Arts, a high energy educational workshop, participants get to delve into the history and philosophy of martial arts in China as well as trying out different styles such as Tai-Chi for themselves.

Chinese Classical Dance

Chinese Classical Dance engages students with an incredible performance of classical folk dances from across China such as the Lantern Dance, Ribbon Dance and Fan Dance. Students will practice a short routine using props, performed to both traditional and contemporary Chinese music.

Chinese Classical Music

This Chinese Classical Music workshop presents the ancient origins of Chinese classical instruments and introduces traditional Chinese music. This is followed by a beautiful performance and an interactive workshop where participants learn a traditional song themselves!

Polynesian Infusion

Take participants on a journey to the Islands with its energetic and enthusiastic performance and interactive workshops. Through a fastpaced combination of music, dance, storytelling and craft, participants will come to know and appreciate the ancient and fascinating cultures of the Pacific.



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Classical Indian Dance

Immerse your students in Indian culture and its traditions dating back to ancient times. After an amazing performance of classical instruments and Sanskrit chants, students will learn some of the symbolic gestures, movements and stories.

Bollywood Infusion

Bollywood is an important part of modern Indian culture, referring to the Hindi film industry, and categorised by colourful displays of music, dance, and costume. Bollywood Infusion presents a vibrant workshop where participants will learn about the folk and classical origins of the Bollywood dances.

Indonesian Infusion

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Indonesian Infusion will take participants on an immersive and interactive journey, showcasing the amazing diversity of the Indonesian community. Through customs, language, dance, traditional dress and music, the presenters explore the islands of Sumatra, Java, Bali and more. This colourful Indonesian Infusion program will give audiences an appreciation and insight into Indonesian culture!

Middle Eastern Belly Dance

Introduce your students to Arab cultures through stories and movement! From classical music to modern pop and dance styles from Egypt to the Arabian Gulf, participants will explore clapping, footwork, arm movements and improvisation in this high-energy program and some of the meanings behind the moves.







Hip Hop Lyrics Writing

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Hip Hop Lyric Writing, led by Rapper Wayde, blends creativity and expression. Students explore hiphop culture, transforming ideas into verses through interactive exercises. The workshop culminates with Wayde performing the students' collective creation and encouraging them to showcase their own lyrical talent, igniting curiosity and confidence in hip-hop artistry.

Hip-Hop Infusion

In this high-energy interactive program, students will learn about hip-hop and urban dance culture around the world. Using a variety of super-danceable beats that will have all students up and dancing, this is the perfect introduction to the expressive world of hip-hop!

Rhythms and Instruments of West Africa

In Rhythms and Instruments of West Africa, the musical cultures of West Africa are explored through rhythms and songs from Ghana, Guinea and Senegal. Students will be introduced to a range of instruments such as the djembe, dun dun drums, shekere, talking drum, balafon and more!

Latino Grooves

Colombian musician Hugo Salcedo teams with Latin dance instructor Julia Gonzalez to present this fun introduction to Latin dance styles like Salsa, Bachata and Brazilian Samba in Latino Grooves! Using traditional as well as contemporary instruments, the duo provide an energetic and insightful music and dance program and can incorporate Spanish language

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Latin American Dance

Explore the vibrant world of Latin American dance through an engaging demonstration of salsa, cha-cha-cha, merengue, bachata, and tango. Discover the rich cultural significance of these dances as participants gain a deeper connection to the rhythms and traditions of Latin America.

Fire of Flamenco

Fire of Flamenco incorporates dance, music and singing and has a rich, multicultural history influenced by Roma, Arab, West African and Spanish cultures. In this program, students will get to try the accompanying 'palmas' (clapping) and learn some flamenco dance moves.

Macedonian Dance and Culture

This interactive program immerses students in Macedonian traditions, customs, and stories passed down through generations. Participants will engage in traditional dances and songs, exploring their origins and cultural significance.

Bella Italia

Napoli native Mira takes students through her childhood to learn about this ancient city. In Bella Italia, students will sing along to Neapolitan folk songs and practice traditional folk dances. The Italian language level can be adjusted to the ability of the students.
